

LOWER POTTS GROVE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

April 20, 2017

The Board of Commissioners of Lower Pottsgrove Township held its regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday, April 20, 2017 at the Lower Pottsgrove Township Municipal Building, 2199 Buchert Road, Pottstown, Pennsylvania. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The following were in attendance:

Board of Commissioners: Bruce L. Foltz, President; Stephen M. Klotz, Vice President; Earl E. Swavely, Jr. and Raymond W. Lopez. Commissioner Mohollen was not in attendance.

Matthew Hovey, Solicitor, Edward C. Wagner, Manager and Sharon Colletti, Secretary were also present.

Commissioner Foltz stated the meeting will be recorded. He expressed his sympathies to Commissioner Klotz on the passing of his mother.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF THE April 3, 2017 MEETING

Commissioner Klotz made the motion to approve the April 3, 2017 minutes. Commissioner Lopez seconded the motion; all in favor (4-0)

NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Klotz made the motion to enter into an Agreement with Ryan Lehman to mow the field at Bleim and Pleasantview Roads. Commissioner Swavely seconded the motion; all in favor (4-0)

Commissioner Klotz made the motion to approve the request for reimbursement for Officer Scott Weidenhammer in the amount of \$4,100, which was budgeted, for tuition to attend the Northwestern University Institute of Staff and Command. Commissioner Swavely seconded the motion; all in favor (4-0)

RESOLUTION AND ORDINANCE:

Commissioner Lopez made the motion to execute Resolution 1135-17 authorizing the auction of the 2008 Ford Taurus. Commissioner Swavely seconded the motion; all in favor (4-0)

Commissioner Lopez made the motion to execute Resolution 818-G disposition of records according to the Municipal Records Manual. Commissioner Klotz seconded the motion; all in favor (4-0)

Commissioner Klotz motioned for the approval of Warrant #859 for the month of March 2017. Commissioner Lopez seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved (4-0)

Commissioner Klotz motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report for March 2017. Commissioner Swavely seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved (4-0)

COMMISSIONERS COMMENTS:

Commissioner Lopez had no comment.

Commissioner Swavely thanked all of the township staff and volunteers for what was, in his opinion, a very successful Easter egg hunt and was enjoyed by all those in attendance.

Commissioner Klotz thanked everyone for the outpouring of support he and his family have received in response to the loss of his mother.

Commissioner Foltz gave an update regarding the streetlight project and announced that with the exception of three items, all of the streetlights have been replaced with new LED lights.

Mr. Wagner mentioned in regards to the street lights that PennDOT had just installed four new high pressure sodium lamps at the Armand Hammer interchange which match the décor of the poles. As a result they were not changed out as part of our upgrade. He stated that J.P. Mascaro had invited the Commissioners and any township staff to tour the Pioneer Crossing recycling center to be held on June 21st from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. In addition he stated that Mr. Nester from PGSD will be at the next meeting presenting the newest report for future enrollment in the schools.

Solicitor Hovey had no comments.

There being no further business, the public meeting was adjourned at 7:10 p.m. The next regularly scheduled meeting will be held on Monday, May 1, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.
