3. Ms. Elliott would find out from the insurance company whether the soccer goals were insurable.

COMMENTS

Ms. Abdalla asked what about the Township's plans for the use of the baseball field at Sanatoga Park. Ms. Elliott said that the board members should make a recommendation as to what they feel would be the best way to handle the use of the fields at Sanatoga Park. She said it had been assumed that due to the severe wear and tear that soccer teams place on a field that the soccer field would be game only. However, it seemed from discussions, that baseball teams are not as hard on a field and it may be able to support more use.

There was discussion on what teams could possibly use the field, what they are currently doing, and what kind of options could be supported. The Board primarily discussed two options: making the field one team's home field for games and practices, with the possibility of allowing a few games from other teams on the field, or making the field a strictly game only field. Ms. Elliott suggested that if the Board would like to make the field one teams home field, that they pay a premium for that privilege, instead of paying a seasonal field reservation fee.

A motion was made by Mr. Troutman, seconded by Ms. Abdalla, and unanimously approved by a 3-0 vote to recommend that one baseball team be allowed to use the Sanatoga Baseball Field as its home field for a period of one year when the field is opened. This arrangement would be re-evaluated at the end of the year to determine whether this is an appropriate action.

Mr. Troutman asked if there was insurance money to build a second pavilion at Sanatoga Park. He recalled that there might be some insurance money to rebuild it after the original pavilion burned down. Ms. Elliott said she was not aware of any plans to build a second pavilion at Sanatoga Park or that there was insurance money to do so. She said she would check into this.

Mr. Wood asked if the Township planned to order new trash cans for the parks. Ms. Elliott said that the Township had ordered several trash/recycle bins for the park through the recycling fund. She said that due to their expense, they were only able to purchase a few and plan to purchase a few each year.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:27 p.m.
