The regularly scheduled Parks and Recreation meeting was held on Monday, April 22, 2013 and was called to order at 7:05PM. The following were in attendance:

Mr. Wood made a motion to accept the April 2013 Report. The motion was seconded by Mr. Troutman and carried by a vote of 4-0.

OLD BUSINESS

Regional Recreation Presentation – Ms. Elliott provided the members with more detailed information on the position of the Regional Recreation Coordinator. This presentation will be subsequently made to the Board of Commissioners for their approval for Lower Pottsgrove Township to move forward in the process and agree to participation in the Regional Recreation Coordinator endeavor.

Discussion on the strategy for Lower Pottsgrove Township's participation followed. Board members decided that it was best to be organized as an individual municipality and create a prioritized list of projects that this individual could assist with. This would help the Township get the most out of the individual's expertise. They agreed to start strategizing on various areas where the coordinator could help them.

Present members agreed that for the resolution to be effective there will need to be a minimum number of municipalities participating in order for the township to commit. It was agreed upon that 3 municipality participants would be the minimum acceptable.

Mr. Cimino made a motion to support the Resolution for a Regional Recreation Coordinator with a requirement of the minimum of three (3) participants. The motion was seconded by Mr. Troutman and carried with a 4-0 vote.

Fundraising - The discussion from the Regional Recreation Coordinator carried over into the fundraising discussion. Board members identified the priority for the Coordinator would be to assist with funding opportunities for key projects the board identifies as a priority in the Township.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business to discuss.

Mr. Wood inquired about the Easter Egg Hunt. Ms. Corley responded that it was a success.
